With reference your application on the subject noted above, I directed to grant recognition to your school from class V to XII with effect from Academic Session 1973-74 for a day school. Following terms and conditions:-

That the school shall abide by the provision of Delhi School Education Act, 1973 and rule 'Kan' under as well as the instructions issued from time to time.

That the school shall admit students without any discrimination of cast and creed as per the norms of the department.

That the school shall appoint full time qualified and eligible staff as per the norms of the department.

That the school shall equip the science lab as per the norms of the department and suitable facilities for practical work shall be provided to the students. More equipment worth Rs. 5,000/- shall be purchased during the session and a list be furnished to the Education Office for verification.

That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading room shall also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of ten books per student may be maintained and facilities of reading room may also be provided immediately and more books worth Rs. 5,000/- be purchased by the start of the next session and the list of books furnished to Education Officer for verification.

Composition based on a visual stimulus such as diagram, picture, graph, map, cartoon or flow chart.

Task will involve the production of a discursive text in which the student is required to express his/her point of view on the topic given.
